The Ohio State University College of Public Health invites applications for a Senior Consulting Research Statistician in the Division of Biostatistics.

This position is 50% in the Institute for Behavioral Medicine Research and 50% in the Division of Biostatistics assisting with faculty-generated research. The applicant will coordinate, conduct, and interpret analyses of biomedical research projects, serve as database manager for research projects; analyze and interpret research data using basic and advanced statistical procedures; assist in the preparation of journal articles, technical reports and grant submissions; develop and prepare new statistical programs targeted at needs of an ongoing projects; assist in preparing budgets and monitoring expenses; supervise graduate students.

The successful applicant must have substantial experience in a statistical field, with additional coursework or experience in public health, biology, or medicine. In particular, they should have experience in managing large databases, working with longitudinal mixed models, and utilizing statistical software packages.

Rank and salary will be determined by the candidate's credentials. Applications will be considered as they arrive and the date of appointment is open to negotiation. Women and other under-represented groups are especially encouraged to apply.
