2. Apply pesticides with various types of equipment to control mosquito populations as necessary at various field sites and residential complaints (using truck).
3. Prepare and maintain equipment and vehicles for daily operation.
4. Maintain accurate records of insecticide application and daily work activities.
5. Collect, sort and maintain accurate records on mosquito collections and chemical treatment for data input.
6. Communicate effectively with the community to; educate citizens on program goals, disease control and activities.
