The purpose of the Epidemiologist position is to perform program development, research, evaluation, and surveillance activities of critical importance and considerable difficulty in the practice of population-based public health. Under limited supervision, initiates and leads the planning, design, and implementation of epidemiologic, research, and evaluation studies, including analysis, and reporting of findings. Works as part of a small research team collaborating with policy and program staff and community partners on innovative projects. Examples include projects designed to reduce infant mortality, childhood lead poisoning, sexually transmitted diseases, and obesity. Works on a wide variety of health issues with the goal of reducing racial/ethnic and socioeconomic health disparities and helps to track progress toward department and city goals.

Education: Masters degree in epidemiology or closely related field is required.

Experience: At least two years of experience in public health surveillance and/or evaluation, or a closely related field, or relevant community experience.
