Description: The George Washington University (GWU) School of Public Health and Health Services and the West Virginia Bureau of Public Health has been funded by the National Cancer Institute (NCI) to conduct a Dissemination-Implementation Research Program (2008-11). The aim of this RO1 is to evaluate the level of adoption and behavioral impact of evidence based tobacco treatment methods for pregnant smokers for a state-wide perinatal program. This collaborative project needs a Research Scientist/Deputy Director to oversee the project implementation. Specific functions will involve: 1. Collaborate with the leadership at the WV Bureau of Public Health and the GWU research team to plan innovative methods to implement and evaluate the program. 2. Supervise research staff. 3. Plan and implement research activities in-line with the specific aims. 4. Conduct and oversee data analysis. 5. Serve as liaison with the funding agency and the project site. 6. Communicate with the funding agency on programmatic and funding issues. 7. Facilitate the Institutional Review Board and project administration at the GWU. 8. Coordinate and manage publication of program research.
