COLLEGE AGREEMENTS:

- Social Work will accept PUBHLTH 6001: Methods in Quantitative Data Analysis (4 credit hours), PUBHHBP 7532: Program Evaluation (3 credit hours), PUBHLTH 7899.01 and 7899.02: Integrative Learning Experience I and II (2 credit hours) to replace Social Work 7401 and 7402. Social Work will ensure that required competencies are met for the Social Work 7401 and 7402 courses and evaluation project (6 credit hours).
- Public Health will accept Social Work 76XX: Integrative Seminar II (3 credit hours) to replace PUBHHBP 7542: Settings and Special Populations in Health Promotion (3 credit hours)
- Public Health will accept Social Work 7189: Advanced Field Education (8 credit hours) to meet the requirements of the MPH Applied Practice Experience (APE) a requirement for all MPH students. Either before registering, or during the 7189 Field Education, students must complete an MPH/MSW Learning Agreement (on the College of Public Health website). This is an abbreviated version of what students pursuing a standalone MPH complete. The agreement has students identify 5 public health competencies they will meet through their Field Education. At the end of the Field Education, students will write up a 1-page summary of their field experience and how it relates to the field of Public Health. They also need to create two work products and submit those to the College of Public Health. Examples of work products can be found on the College of Public Health website:

The summary and the work products need to be submitted through email at <u>CPH-</u> <u>Practiceedandcareerservices@osu.edu</u>. Most agency sites should be able to include a Public Health focus for the advanced field education.

Graduation:

• Since Social Work is a course based Master's Degree, students in the dual degree program will complete the traditional MPH Integrative Learning Experience Project within their Social Work field practicum site whenever possible. The MPH Integrative Learning Experience Project will substitute for the evaluation project required of Social Work 7401 and 7402.
