The College of Public Health understands the importance of providing students with experiences to take what is learned in the classroom and apply that knowledge to our community and to the world. These opportunities enhance and enrich student's educational experiences and outcomes.

Global Health travel awards are available to undergraduate and graduate students participating in international study, practicum experiences, research or other health activities that will have a meaningful impact on their education and who have completed at least one year of study.

The Farm to Table award is available to any graduate student in Public Health traveling with the Farm to Table program.

- Students are only eligible to receive a travel award once.
 - The **maximum** amount of an award will be \$1,500, and will be decided upon by a committee of faculty who will review applications and award based on academic credentials, financial need, and narrative answers.
 - Requests may not exceed \$1,500 and matching support is encouraged for all requests.
 - Awards will be distributed to the recipient half before the travel has occurred, and the other half upon completion of the project and submittal of a summary of the outcome of the project.
